### Playground Fee per Child:

**\$50 for Greenport Residents**

(Proof of residency is required: tax bill, utility bill of parent, etc.)

**\$125 for Non-Residents**

Please remember the following:

- ❖ You must sign out your child every day!
  - Once a child has signed out, he/she will not be able to return on that day.
- ❖ The playground will be closed on rainy days. Listen to your local radio station WCTW 93.5 or login and check on our Facebook page. The decision to close will be made by 7:50 am.
- ❖ Bring a bag lunch with an ice pack to prevent food from spoiling. Bring lots of water!
- ❖ There is a snack bar that serves lunch as well! Prices to be determined.
  - Children must sign up by 10:30 if they plan on ordering lunch.
- ❖ Breakfast snacks will be available for purchase from 8:00 -10:00 at the snack bar.
  - Candy, ice cream, and soda will not be served prior to 10:30.
  - You may bring in a sealed envelope labeled with your child's name for snack bar purchases throughout the week. Amount cannot exceed \$20. The concession stand staff will collect and keep track of the balance for you.
- ❖ Every Friday we will be selling pizza and soda. The order must be placed by 10:00 am. No orders will be accepted after this time. The price is to be determined.
- ❖ Bring a bathing suit and towel each day as we may play water games.
- ❖ Important Notes and Upcoming Events will be posted near the pick-up station and/or sent home with your child.

**Behavior Contract:**

Because of the great number of children in the playground program, the staff requires all parents and children to read and sign a behavior contract. The following rules will be enforced for the safety of all children and staff. If the child repeatedly breaks the rules three or more times he/she will be suspended or expelled from the program.

**1<sup>st</sup> offense:** Warning      **2<sup>nd</sup> offense:** Phone Call Home      **3<sup>rd</sup> offense:** Suspension/Expelled

\*\*These may change due to the severity of behavior.\*\*

**There will be NO:**

- \*Swearing
- \*Hitting/Fighting
- \*Drugs/Alcohol
- \*Disregard to safety rules
- \* Biking or Skating on the grounds
- \*Engaging in dangerous behaviors
- \*Unruly bus behavior on trips
- \*Unruly behavior on trips/events
- \*Throwing Objects
- \*Inappropriate Materials
- \*Disrespect
- \*Bullying
- \*Stealing

I understand that my child can and will be expelled from the program if he/she does not follow the rules. I have discussed these rules with my child and he/she also agrees to follow them. In addition, I agree that my child will not be dropped off before 8:00am or remain at the playground after 2:30pm, since there will be no supervision provided at those times.

**PLEASE READ!! IMPORTANT INFORMATION! PLEASE READ!!****Please keep this page for your records! ☺**

1. Always have an emergency plan and person available in case of an early closing during the day. Due to the lack of an indoor facility we cannot house the children in the event of a thunderstorm.
2. In the event of rain in the morning, playground closings will be announced by **7:50 a.m.** Listen to the radio station **WCTW 93.5** or **login to Facebook** and check on our site.
3. There is no supervision after 2:30 p.m. Playground activities end at 2:00! Please be on time to pick up your child!
4. Read and discuss the following rules with your child. Repeated violations will result in suspension from the playground. Our major concern is safety for all!
  - a. No swearing or offensive language.
  - b. No hitting, kicking, spitting, biting, fighting, etc.
  - c. No throwing objects.
  - d. Listen to and respect counselors.
  - e. Follow safety rules – dangerous behavior is not acceptable.
  - f. No Stealing
  - g. No riding or skateboarding on the grounds (only to and from park).
  - h. Use proper behavior on all field trips.
  - i. Play, have fun, and make new friends!
5. Permission/Information slips will go home before each field trip or event. Plan ahead! We WILL NOT accept any late slips due to space availability. PLEASE SEND ALL SLIPS AND MONEY IN A SEALED ENVELOPE WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME AND THE AMOUNT ENCLOSED.

  - b. Greenport Recreation Program T-Shirts MUST be worn by all campers that attend field trips. They will not be allowed to go if they do not have one.
