Declaration of Local State of Emergency in Response to COVID-19

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 1 OF 2020.1


WHEREAS, on March 17, 2020, I issued an Executive Order declaring a local state of emergency in the Town of Greenport (the "Declaration of Emergency"); and

WHEREAS, both travel-related cases and community contact transmission of COVID-19 have been documented in New York State and Columbia County and are expected to continue; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kathleen Eldridge, Supervisor of the Town of Greenport, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of the State of New York, do hereby issue this Executive Order dated April 1, 2020, and I hereby declare the Orders enumerated in the Declaration of Emergency for an additional thirty (30) days or until May 1, 2020.

FURTHER, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Section 24 of Article 2-B of the New York State Executive Law to temporarily suspend or modify any statute, local law, ordinance, order, rule, or regulation or parts thereof, of any agency during a State disaster emergency, and in accordance with Executive Orders issued by Governor Cuomo, any meetings of the Town Board or Planning Board may be conducted by teleconference, subject to proper public notice.
